

This order shall dispose of **pre-arrest bail** application of the accused/petitioner **Muhammad Nabi** s/o Mardan Shah r/o Ali Khel caste, Tapa Ibrahim Khel, PO Ghiljo, Kot Kallay, Upper Orakzai; who is charged in case **FIR No. 18**, dated 27-04-2020, u/ss. **33 NDMA Act, 2010, 506/186/188/189 PPC of PS Upper Orakzai**.

The facts of the case, according to record, are; that a murasila was sent by Assistant Commissioner, Upper Orakzai Haider Hussain (complainant), to the local police station, on 27-04-2020, for registration of FIR. The complainant reported that he, along with Tehsildar, visited the mosques and bazars for implementing instructions/SOPs regarding precautionary measures of Covid-19. That one Najeeb Ur Rehman (co-accused), and 10-12 un-named persons, were sitting in a small shop; that they were directed to close the shop and follow Covid-19 SOPs; that some left the shop but others started using foul language; that they also scuffled with security officials and criminally intimidated the officials. The complainant further alleged that the said person/s had also tried to instigate the local shopkeepers against the following of Covid-19 SOPs on 25-04-2020.


An FIR was registered on this complaint. During investigation the name of accused/petitioner was revealed to the IO by some special informer, on 20-05-2020 (i.e. about 03 weeks after the occurrence). Hence the instant petition.

Arguments of counsel for the accused/petitioner and DPP for State heard; the available record perused. Tentative assessment of which, for the purpose of deciding instant petition, shows that:

1. The accused/petitioner has been nominated as accused by some unnamed person, allegedly a police spy, almost 03 weeks after the occurrence.
2. According to statement of main accused, Najeeb Ur Rehman, recorded u/s 161 CrPC, the security staff of complainant had attacked him (Najeeb Ur Rehman); however, no investigation has been made in this regard. In these circumstances malafide on behalf of the complainant and local police cannot be ruled out.
3. The accused/petitioner has not been identified by the complainant, at the time of report or investigation.
4. All the sections of law imposed are bailable.
5. The BBA of main accused, Najeeb Ur Rehman, has already been confirmed by the Worthy Sessions Judge.
6. The accused/petitioner joined investigation since grant of interim BBA on 03-06-2020, but so far, no material has been brought on record against him.

Resultantly, the instant pre-arrest bail petition of accused Muhammad Nabi, is **accepted** and the ad-interim pre-arrest bail already granted to him is confirmed on the existing bail bonds. Copy of this order be placed on record. Record be returned while this file be consigned to record room after necessary completion and compilation.
