2. Accused/petitioner, Muhammad Khan seeks his release on bail in case FIR No. 42, dated 15.05.2020 registered U/S 489-B PPC at Police Station Lower Orakzai Kalaya, wherein he is charged for having in his possession 6 counterfeit Pakistani currency notes of Rs. 1,000/- denomination each.

From the arguments and record available on file, it reveals that allegedly the alleged forged currency notes were found in simple possession of the accused/petitioner as such at the most section 489-C PPC would be attracted to the case of accused/petitioner which isailable in nature and accused/petitioner is entitled inailable cases for bail as matter of right.
