
MUHAMMAD SHABBIR ETC VS THE STATE

ORDER

DPP, Umar Niaz for State and Sanaullah Khan Advocate Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Record already received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

2. Accused/petitioners, Muhammad Shabbir and Noor Saif Khan seek their release on bail in case FIR No. 43, dated 04.12.2019 registered U/S 9(D) CNSA at Police Station Lower Orakzai, wherein they are charged for having in their possession 2 packets Chars each (4 packets in total) each packet 1200grams (4800grams 4.8kg in total).

3. From the arguments and record available on file, it reveals that accused/petitioners are directly and by name charged for the day light occurrence. Recovery of Chars was effected from the exclusive possession of the accused/petitioners. Witnesses support the version of the prosecution. Offence do



connect the accused/petitioners with the

dismissed being meritless.
