Naqal Madd No. 16. The grounds for discharge are already mentioned in application of prosecution u/s 4-CII/5-B of prosecution Act 2005 read with sec. 494 Cr.P.C which is available on file. Accused/respondent in person present. Argument heard.</p> <p>Perusal of record available on file shows that local police charged the accused in Naqal Madd. 16, Dated: 19.04.2024, complaint u/s 468/471 PPC at Police Station Kurez Boya, Lower Orakzai.</p> <p>As per record evidence is deficient; Neither the accused/respondent has not been arrested on the spot nor any recovery has been affected from possession of the accused. There is no independent witness of the occurrence.</p> <p>In view of above, I myself with the view of prosecution is agreeable and there is no chance of conviction of accused/respondent in the instant complaint if entire evidence is recorded. Further, proceedings in the instant complaint, would be a futile exercise and misuse of resources. Therefore, accused/respondent Tasdeeq Ali s/o Amjad Ali is hereby discharged from the charges levelled against him.
