Summarized fact of the case, accordingly to FIR, are that the local police had recovered chars weighing 4000 grams from the bag which was laying with the back seat passengers which was taken into possession along with the motorcycle in question.

## SHER REHMAN VS STATE Cri. Misc. App. No. 04/04, FIR No. 63 of 12.11.2024

Arguments heard available record perused which shows that the motorcycle in question is purchased by present petitioner from one Alam Khan s/o Sabar Khan and there is no secret cavity in the motorcycle in question, furthermore, the alleged recovery has been made from the bag present with the back seat passenger. The petitioner also stated that no recovery of any narcotics has been made from his possession. The motorcycle is parked in the police station and there is apprehension of its deterioration if the same is left on attended in the police station for indefinite period. I, therefore accept the instant petition and it is hereby directed that the motorcycle mentioned above be handed over to the petitioner, Sher Rehman subject to furnishing of bonds in the sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each like amount to the satisfaction of the SHO PS concerned. The petitioner shall be bound to produce the motorcycle in question before any court of law or investigating officer as and when required. The SHO is directed to place copy of the bonds on record. Copy of this order also be placed on the main case file while record of this court be consigned to record room.
