DPP, Umar Niaz for the state and Khursheed Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Complainant present through her uncle. Record has already been received. Arguments heard and record gone through.

- 2. Accused/petitioner, Tazeem Ali s/o Khyal Jan Ali seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 13, Dated 13.02.2025 u/s 4 Ghag Act registered at Police Station Kurez Boya, wherein, as per contents of FIR registered on the basis of an application submitted by the complainant and her sister to the Police Officer, District Orakzai, the accused/petitioner and his co-accused have restrained Mst. Gul Yarma and Mst. Gulshan, daughters of Ghadeer Ali, of marrying someone else.
- Perusal of the case file reveals that though the accused/petitioner is directly charged in the FIR for the offence which is shocking to the public morality but it does not fall within the prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. More importantly, the accused/petitioner submitted an affidavit through his counsel which is duly supported by the sureties, Ayan Ali and Darwish Ali, wherein it has been undertaken by the accused/petitioner that neither he has committed Ghag on the complainant or her sister Syed Chaidullah Shah nor he has any intention to do so in future, leaving

them at liberty to enter into a marriage contract with their consent and will. The affidavit is placed on file as Ex. PA. The complainant party assured that they are fully satisfied with the affidavit submitted by the accused/petitioner; therefore, they have got no objection if the accused/petitioner is released on bail.

- 4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, bail petition in hand stands accepted and the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in the sum of Rs. 80,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
- 5. Order announced. File of this court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
- 6. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.
- 7. This Order is tentative in nature and would have no effect upon the trial of the accused/petitioner.
