


Order No. 59	08.03.2025	<p>Parties alongwith counsels present.</p> <p>Today the case in hand was fixed for plaintiff evidence but the same is not available before the Court once again and plaintiff sought adjournment for production of his evidence.</p> <p>In given circumstances, perusal of previous order sheets would reveal that the case in hand was initially fixed for official plaintiff evidence on 26.08.2023 and court had directed plaintiff to submit diet money for official witnesses, but after lapse of about one month, plaintiff failed to submit diet money for official witnesses. Further order sheets would reveal that plaintiff submitted diet money after one month, the official witness was summoned and appeared before the court and his statement was recorded as PW-01 on 21.10.2023.</p> <p>Perusal of the previous order sheets would further transpire that the Court vide order no. 40 dated 04.11.2023 by serving notice under Order XVII Rule 3 CPC provided a very last opportunity to the plaintiff and had directed him to produce his entire evidence on the next date of hearing and had further informed plaintiff</p>

However, on the next date of hearing the evidence of plaintiff was not present and thus the court by imposing cost of Rs. 1000/- extended notice under Order XVII Rule 3 CPC and directed plaintiff to produce his evidence on next date. Subsequently on the next date once again the plaintiff evidence was not present before the court and thus the court extended notice under Order XVII Rule 3 CPC for third time. It is also worth mentioning here that after lapse of about 17 months plaintiff evidence has not been concluded.</p> <p>As stated earlier, today neither evidence of plaintiff is present before the court nor his counsel.</p> <p>Keeping in view the above mentioned facts and conduct of plaintiff, this court is of the view that plaintiff is not interested to pursue the instant case. Hence, accordingly the suit in hand is hereby dismissed under Order XVII Rule 3 CPC.
