<u>Order.No.03</u> 17.03.2025

None present for the state. Complainant along with counsel present. Arguments on behalf of counsel for accused/petitioner already heard. Record already received. Arguments on behalf of counsel for complainant heard and record gone through.

Accused/petitioner namely Miraj Gul S/O Qabil Khan, R/O Qaum Mishti, Tehsil Central, District Orakzai is seeking his post arrest bail in case FIR No.10, Dated:09.03.2025 U/S 506, 427, 34, 34 PPC, PS Mishti Mela, Orakzai.

Offences U/S 427 is bailable in nature. As far as Section 506 PPC is concerned, it has been leveled for advancing threats of dire consequences to complainant by accused/petitioners. Offences with which accused/petitioner is charged does not fall within the ambit of prohibitory clause of Section 497 Cr.PC. In such like cases grant of bail is a rule and refusal is an exception. No such extra ordinary circumstances are available on record. Investigation has already been completed and accused/petitioner is no more required to the local police for further investigation and no useful purpose would be served by keeping the accused/petitioner behind the bar.
