ORDER

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present. Record received. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, Mst. Shama alias Shazia w/o Jaffar Shah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 27, Dated 25.05.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (d) CNSA of Police Station Kurez Boya. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Aftab Hassan SHO along with other police personnel, acting on information regarding smuggling of narcotics by a female, set up a picket on the crime scene where at about 1320 hours a Flying-Coach bearing Registration No. 1005 was stopped for the purpose of checking. A female along with two children alongside a bag occupying a seat in the third row were present who was disembarked. Nothing incriminating was recovered from her personal search. The complainant recovered 05 packets of chars wrapped with yellow colour scotch tape from the bag, each amounted to 1200

grams, making a total of 6,000 grams of chars.

Hence, the present FIR.

evident record

accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR

and the offence for which she is charged attracts the

prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. Moreover,

sufficient material is available on file which

reasonably connect the accused/petitioner with the

commission of offence, particularly the statement of

driver of the vehicle in which the accused was

travelling. Application for FSL is also available on

record. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled

for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly,

for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands

dismissed being meritless.

compilation.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.

6. This Order is tentative in nature and would have no

effect upon the trial of the accused/petitioner.
