


## **ORDER**

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State and Abid Ali Advocate for accused/petitioners present. Record received. Injured Hazrat Ullah present through his father Mast Ali Shah. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioners, Aqal Khan and Yousaf Khan both s/o Ameen Khan seek their post arrest bail in case FIR No. 43, Dated 29.05.2025, u/s 302/506/34 PPC and 15AA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Muhammad Younas SHO during surveillance of the area received information regarding firing between the accused/petitioners and Latif Khan and Ameen Ullah as a result of dispute over home construction. The complainant along with other police contingents reached there and came to know that the parties had fired upon each other and that a passerby, namely Hazrat Ullah s/o Mast Ali Shah has received fire shot and has been injured. Hence, the present FIR.
