

ORDER

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State and Ishtiaq Ur Rehman Advocate for accused/petitioner present.  
Record received. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Shafeer Ullah** s/o Hamza Ali seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 14, Dated 02.06.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Ghiljo. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Tajmin Khan ASHO along with other police contingents were on routine surveillance of the area when he received information regarding paddling of narcotics from Mamozai via motorcycle. The complainant, responding to the information, set up a picket on the crime scene. At about 2010 hours, a red colour motorcycle without registration number boarded by two persons heading towards the picket, on seeing the police party accelerated the motorcycle and were chased by the police. However, one of them made his escape good from the spot while the other was overpowered but nothing incriminating was recovered from his personal search. The search of the



motorcycle, led the complainant to the recovery of 05 packets of chars, amounting to 4000 grams from a secret cavity. The person arrested on the spot revealed his identity as Muhammad Faizan. During interrogation, he also disclosed the name of co-accused as Shafeer Khan (the present accused/petitioner). Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the accused/petitioner is nominated in the FIR on the basis of statement of co-accused. The accused/petitioner was neither arrested on the spot nor the recovery was affected from his possession. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.
4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
