ORDER

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State and Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner present.

Arguments have already been heard and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Zahid Ullah** s/o Yar Akbar seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 47, Dated 05.06.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Muhammad Younas SHO along with other police contingents set up a picket on the spot.

At about 1800 hours, the complainant stopped a red colour Pick-Up heading from Mishti Mela towards

A passenger with a black bag in his lap occupying a seat was disembarked from the vehicle, but nothing incriminating was recovered from his personal search. From the said bag, the complainant recovered 03 packets of chars, each weighing 1200 grams, making a total of 3600 grams. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record. was found that though accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR and the offense falls within the prohibitory clause of Section 497 CrPC. However, there is no application or route permit certificate to show that the samples were transmitted to FSL within the prescribed period of time. The driver and cleaner of the vehicle, from which the accused was apprehended, were not associated with the recovery proceedings nor their statements were recorded. These facts make the case one of further inquiry.

- 4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in sum of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
