





IO concerned submitted his report which is placed on file.</p> <p>Vide this order the Court intend to dispose of the instant Superdari petition filed by petitioner Banaras Khan son of Khwagat Shah, resident of Qom Feroz Khel, Tapa Jaisai Khel, District Orakzai who is seeking return of one Motorcar Toyota Corolla in white color bearing chassis no. CE106-0088307 and engine no. 00849000, previously taken into possession by local police of Police Station Mishti Mela, in Case FIR no. 07 dated 06.02.2025 under section 279 Pakistan Panel Code &amp; 15 KPAA.</p> <p>Arguments already heard and record perused.</p> <p>Record reveals that motorcar in question was taken into possession by the local police in the above cited case and is in the custody of local police of PS Mishti Mela. Copies of the relevant documents are annexed with the petition. Original NDP Vehicle Identification Slip produced and returned after examination. Petitioner is the last possessor of the said vehicle. There is no rival claimant of the vehicle. The vehicle is parked in open space which is likely to be rusted, damaged and deteriorated. Detention of vehicle in question in police custody for indefinite period would also achieve no useful purpose.
