Order No. 02 continued	20.06.2025	<p>The fact that complainant has settled the dispute with the accused, has consented to his release on bail, and is present today before the court to endorse his position indicates that the matter was not grave enough to rule out compromise.</p> <p>Law, by default, sides with bail rather than jail. Only when the commission of crime is sufficiently probable, and the nature and gravity of the alleged offence makes the accused person a flight risk or threat to the community, is bail to be withheld.</p> <p>In view of the said statement, I hereby accept the present application.
