

The rider of the motorcycle disclosed his name as Ashiq Ali s/o Imdad Hussain.</p> <p>(3). The petitioner present before the court produced original registration documents of the motorcycle which is seen and returned.</p> <p>(4). Arguments heard and record gone through.</p> <p>(5). Perusal of the case file reveals that the petitioner is the last possessor of the motorcycle in question. At present there is no rival claimant. Moreover, the investigation in the instant case is complete and the motorcycle in question is no more required for further investigation. The prosecution also raised no objection, if the motorcycle in question is returned to the petitioner.</p> <p>(6). In these circumstances, the petition in hand is accepted and the motorcycle in question be returned to the petitioner subject to furnishing two surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- to the satisfaction of SHO concerned.</p> <p>(7).
