






Contin. Order No.08		<p>During the course of arguments, the parties were persuaded to resolve the dispute through ADR. Both the counsel for the parties were directed to patch up the matter between the parties. Resultantly, the parties today recorded their joint statement and submitted that the matter has been patched up between them in the following terms;</p> <p><i>"The decretal amount of Rs. 700,000/- shall be paid by the respondent to the appellant in seven (07) monthly installments at the rate of Rs. 100,000/- per month. The first installment shall be paid on 23rd July, 2025, whereafter the remaining six (06) installments shall be paid on first date of each month from September 2025 onward. The appellant shall hand over original documents of the vehicle to the respondent after payment of last installment. He will also co-operate with the respondent in case of his requirement before the officials/police."</i></p> <p>The joint statement was endorsed by both the counsel for the parties.</p> <p>The appeal is disposed of accordingly.
