## **ORDER**

Accused/petitioner present through his counsel. Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Muhammad Zubair** s/o Razeem Khan seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 52, Dated 24.06.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Muhammad Younas SHO along with other police contingents set up a picket on the spot. At about 1400 hours, the complainant stopped a person who was holding a blue plastic shopper in his right-hand. From the said shopper, the complainant, recovered 2400 grams of chars. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with the allegations of recovery of 2400 grams of chars. However, there is no application or route permit certificate to show that the sample was

transmitted to FSL within the prescribed period of time. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.

- 4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
