




As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Islam Ali ASHO along with other police contingents during routine patrolling in an official vehicle were present on the spot on 15.02.2025, when a motorcycle boarded by two persons arrived there at about 1200 hours who attempted to turn the motorcycle but were overpowered. From the said bag, the complainant recovered 13 packets of chars, each weighing 1000 grams and wrapped in yellow colour scotch tape, making a total of 13,000 grams.</p> <p>I heard counsels for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the recovery has been made from personal possession of the accused and there is no secret cavity in the motorcycle in question. Moreover, the petitioner has produced documents regarding ownership of the motorcycle. There is no rival claimant of the motorcycle in question. Above all, it has already been exhibited before the Court at the time of recording the statement of complainant during trial.</p> <p>In view of above, the petition in hand is accepted and the motorcycle in question be returned to the petitioner subject to furnishing two surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 200,000/- to the satisfaction of SHO concerned. The petitioner is directed not to dispose of the motorcycle till final conclusion of the trial and produced the same as and whenever required to this Court or police.
