

**ORDER**

Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner and Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Savid** s/o Ghotay seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 59, Dated 15.07.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Amir Khan ASHO along with other police contingents were on surveillance duty in the area on 15.07.2025 at main road Mishti Mela to Sra Naka. The complainant stopped a suspicious person holding a black chaddar in his right-hand. From the said chaddar, the complainant recovered one packet of chars wrapped with yellow colour scotch tape, weighing 1000 grams. Hence, the present FIR.


3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with the allegation of recovery of 1000 grams of

chars. However, the report of FSL is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.
