		applicant got closer, the respondents aimed their weapons
		and forced Badshah Khan, who was driving the tractor, to
		get down and took out the tractor's key. They abducted
		the applicant's brother, in his presence and forcefully
		took him towards Indara. He immediately rushed to the
		police station and reported the matter to the police. The
		respondent No. 8/SHO handed over the tractor to the
		applicant. The SHO did not take any legal action against
		the respondents No. 1 to 6 as they are relative inter se.
		Therefore, the present application was submitted.
		It is evident from the comments of the SHO
		concerned that the local police have already taken
		cognizance vide Daily Diary No. 4 dated 12.06.2025 and
		has conducted the inquiry u/s 157 (1) of the Criminal
		Procedure Code, 1898. The SHO is directed to submit the
		same before the Illaqa Magistrate at the earliest.
		In such circumstances, the application is disposed
