ORDER

Accused/petitioner present through his counsel, Zahoor Ur Rehman Advocate. Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. I heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, Sher Afzal s/o Sulaiman Shah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 46, Dated 05.06.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Muhammad Younas SHO along with other police contingents set up a picket on the spot, when a motorcycle riding by a person having a Chaddar/shawl in his lap on the way from Hangu was stopped by the complainant at about 1400 hours. The rider was disembarked. From the said chaddar, the complainant recovered 02 packets of chars, each wrapped in yellow scotch tape and weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 2000 grams of chars. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it found that though was the

accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with the allegations of recovery of 2000 grams of chars. However, the FSL report is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.

- 4 Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail provided he submits a bail bond in sum of Rs. 80,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
