		Before arriving at a decision, it is advised to address the
		claim of accused no 02 being juvenile. It is contended by the
		counsel that accused no 02 is under-age, and therefore
,		deserving of the concession recommended by law in favor of
		juveniles accused of offense. He claims that subject accused
		has not acquired CNIC yet. Even the card of arrest shows his
		age to be 18-19 years. In these circumstances, when the
		prosecution has placed him on the verge of majority, the
		court is inclined to read the doubt in his favor.
		With the observations above, petition in favor of
		accused no 02 is accepted. He shall be released on bail
		subject to payment bonds to the tune of Rs.70,000/- with 02

	·	court; however, the court is disinclined to accept the bail
	•	plea of accused no 01.
