


Record received.</p> <p>The petitioners namely (1) Aman Ullah s/o Akram Khan vide bail petition no. <b>47/BA</b> and (2) Muhammad Ilyas s/o Sunab Gul vide bail petition no. <b>48/BA</b> have applied for their post arrest bail in connection with case FIR No. 36, Dated: <sup>19</sup>18.07.2025, U/S 15-AA, 16-AA/34  PPC, registered in PS: Kurez Boya, L/Orakzai. <b>IJAZ MAH</b>  Senior C  Orakzai at</p> <p>Arguments heard and file perused.</p> <p>The offense for which the accused is charged carries a punishment of 10 years to life in prison. During the course of argument, the court was not guided to any major procedural irregularity in the police operation. 425 rounds of 12.7 bore HMG were recovered from the secret cavities of the vehicle driven by the accused.</p> <p>A magistrate presiding over a criminal court cannot be forgetful of the law-and-order conditions of the area under his jurisdiction. Order No. 02 continued	23.07.2025	<p>Only this week 03 major incidents of terrorism took place in the district and its vicinity. Law and order are at its lowest point in the context. With these circumstances in the district, the fact that the accused persons were intercepted with large cache of ammunition of heavy machine guns, is at best very poor exercise of discretion on their part.</p> <p>Before arriving at a decision, it is advised to address the claim of accused no 02 being juvenile. It is contended by the counsel that accused no 02 is under-age, and therefore deserving of the concession recommended by law in favor of juveniles accused of offense. He claims that subject accused has not acquired CNIC yet. Even the card of arrest shows his age to be 18-19 years. In these circumstances, when the prosecution has placed him on the verge of majority, the court is inclined to read the doubt in his favor.</p> <p>With the observations above, petition in favor of accused no 02 is accepted. He shall be released on bail subject to payment bonds to the tune of Rs.70,000/- with 02 sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court; however, the court is disinclined to accept the bail plea of accused no 01.</p> <p>Copy of this order be placed on police record and the instant file be consigned to record room while record be sent back to the quarter concerned.</p> <p>File be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion and compilation.</p> <p><b><u>Announced</u></b> 23.07.2025</p> <p> Ijaz Mahsood Senior Civil Judge/JM, Orakzai (at Baber Mela)</p>
