Sr.PP for the state present. Petitioner Rehmat Ullah present. Record received. Arguments heard and record perused.

Petitioner namely Rehmat Ullah SO Mal Din Khan R/O Qaum Qambar Khel, District Khyber is seeking return of motorcar bearing registration 1058 KHYA, Engine No.1ZZ-589307, Chassis No. ZZE122-3175699 taken into possession by the local police in case FIR No.48 dated: 29.08.2025 U/S 15-AA, Police Station Kurez Boya.

Record reveals that motorcar in question was taken into possession by the local police in the above cited case and is in the custody of local police of PS Kurez Boya. Copy of vehicle registration book is annexed with the petition. Original registration book produced and returned after examination. Petitioner is the owner and last possessor of the said vehicle. There is no rival claimant of the vehicle. The vehicle is parked in open space which is likely to be rusted, damaged and deteriorated. Detention of vehicle in question in police custody for indefinite period would also achieve no useful purpose. Release of the vehicle on superdari to the petitioner will not create any vested

for the custody of the property during pending inquiry/trial.

As petitioner is the owner and last possessor and the vehicle in question and the same is no more required to the local police for investigation, resultantly, the application is accepted and it is directed that the vehicle in question be handed over to the petitioner, subject to surety bonds to the tune of Rs. 1000,000/- (ten lakh) with two sureties to the satisfaction of SHO Police Station concerned. Petitioner shall produce the same as and when required. Record be returned back to the quarter concerned. Copy of the order be placed on file.
