



**Order. 26**

Accused Sadi Khan on bail present. Rest of the accused are exempted. Complainant absent. PWs absent.

Today, the case was fixed for recording evidence of prosecution, however, statement could not have recorded as PWs are not before the court today.

Accused after being charged for the commission of the offence were arrested and later on, released on bail. Challan was put in court against accused. Accused were summoned who appeared before the court and formal charge was framed to which accused pleaded not guilt and claimed trial. Thereafter, prosecution was allowed to produce its evidence. But thereafter, neither statement of PWs have been recorded nor complainant appeared before the court.

Perusal of record reveals that complainant namely Ghani Khan did not bother to appear before the court. Complainant remained absent vide order No.18 to order No.22, order No. 24 to 25. His last appearance before the court was on 21.04.2025, which shows lacks of interest in the instant case.

*As per section 249 Cr. PC when complainant did not appear before the court, Court has the power to stop the proceedings at any stage without pronouncing any judgement either of acquittal or conviction, and may thereupon release the accused.*

In the given circumstances, court has decided to acquit the accused facing trial in the instant case U/S 249 Cr. PC. They are on bail. Their bail bonds stand cancelled. Sureties of accused discharged from their liability. Case property, if any be kept intact.
