


Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present.</p> <p>The petitioner seeks return of a Pick-Up of model 1986 bearing Registration No. B3147, Chassis No. LN 56-0064090 and Engine No. 2L1193821 taken into possession by the local police in case FIR No. 18, Dated 03.05.2023, u/s 9 (d) of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Control of Narcotic Substances Act, 2019, of Police Station Kurez Boya. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Hassan Jan SHO along with other police contingents, during surveillance duty of the area, received information regarding smuggling of narcotics through Dotson No. BD 3148. Upon this information, the complainant set up a picket on the spot when the Dotson No. BD3148 heading from Anjani arrived there at about 1630 hours. The vehicle was stopped. The driver was disembarked who disclosed his identify as Saddam Khan. Order No.04		<p>weighing 1100 grams, making a total of 82,500 grams from a secret cavity made inside the vehicle.</p> <p>I heard counsels for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the vehicle in question was found in possession of the accused Saddam Khan at the time of registration of case. He was convicted vide judgment dated 13.02.2024 by the court of Additional Sessions Judge-II, Orakzai and the vehicle in question was confiscated to State. The said judgment was set aside by the Hon'ble Peshawar High Court, Peshawar, vide judgment dated 30.04.2025, passed in Cr. A No. 216-P of 2022. Thereafter, the petitioner submitted the instant application for superdari of the vehicle No. B3147. He has annexed documents of registration in respect of the said vehicle which contains the name of one Aulas Khan as owner of the vehicle. According to record, vehicle No. BD 3148 was involved in the instant case whereas the petitioner seeks the superdari of vehicle No. B 3147 which was not impounded by the local police in the case in hand.
