rushed to the spot and found the dead body of

Japan Khan. The complainant, Mst. Abida (wife of

the deceased), made a report to the local police on

28.08.2025 at 1340 hours that she was present in

her house when she heard hue and cry; upon which


she came out of her house and saw the accused



died on the spot. She also reported that the offense was committed with abetment of the accused/petitioners. A dispute over the shop was reported as motive for the occurrence.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the petitioners are charged in the FIR, but no specific role has been attributed to them rather the allegations against them fall under Section 109 PPC. In such circumstances, the case against the accused/petitioners is one of further inquiry.
4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioners are admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 300,000/- with two sureties, each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
