


Arguments already heard and record perused.</p> <p>Through this application, the accused/petitioner seeks his pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 96, Dated 26.08.2025, u/s 419/420/468/471 PPC registered at Police Station Kalaya.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the FIR in question was registered on the basis of order dated 28.08.2025 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate, Tehsil Courts Kalaya, on the basis of inquiry u/s 156 (3) of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1898. A revision petition bearing No. 5/10 of 2025, preferred by the petitioner against the said order, was accepted and the impugned order was set aside by this Court vide order of the day. Hence, the BBA petition has become infructuous. It is, therefore, disposed of accordingly.
