Petitioner through along with counsel present. Ex-parte arguments already heard and record gone through.

Perusal of case file reveals that the instant petition is instituted by the petitioner namely **Mazid Khan S/O Yaqin Khan** for his appointment as legal guardian for the person of the namely **Hashmat Khan** mentioned in the petition for the purpose of issuance CNIC and that the petitioner is the real grandfather of the Hashmat Khan and that father and mother have been died on 12.04.2007 and 17.06.2021.

The respondents/general public were summoned through publication in newspaper "Daily Ausaf" dated: 12.09.2025, however none turned up as legal guardian of Hashmat Khan other than the petitioner. Therefore, the Senior Civil Judge respondents were proceeded against ex-parte. Consequently, petitioner produced ex-parte evidence.

During course of recording evidence, Mazid Khan (petitioner) appeared and recorded his statement as PW-01. Jumat Khan deposed as PW-02. Hashmat Khan deposed as PW-03 and Abdul Ghafar deposed as PW-04. PW-01 produced death certificates of parents of Hashmat Khan as Ex.PW-1/1 and Ex.PW-1/2, publication as Ex.PW-1/3, copy of his CNIC

as Ex.PW-1/4. Contents of the petition were reproduced and verified by the witnesses.

At this stage there seems to be no clash of interest between Hashmat Khan and the petitioner, being the real grandfather, in the light of statements of witnesses produced by the petitioner, it is evident that Hashmat Khan is residing presently with the petitioner, who is looking after him. As a real grandfather, he is most likely to take care of the welfare of him. Therefore, the petition in hand is accepted under Section-07 of Guardian & Wards Act, 1890 and petitioner is appointed as guardian of the person of Hashmat Khan for the purpose of issuance CNIC from NADRA.

The guardianship certificate shall remain purpose specific as the proposed ward is already major. Any act or transaction other than specified hereinabove shall be conducted with the leave the of court.

Original guardianship certificate be given to the petitioner subject to surety bonds of Rs.500,000/-(five lacs) with two local and reliable sureties, while copy of the certificate be placed on file.

File be consigned to the record room after its necessary completion

and compilation.
