Contrary respondents/defendants no.01 to 03 stated that suit property known as *Nari Kanrey Patay* is their ancestral property. Plaintiffs/respondents have no concern with the suit property and the contesting respondents/defendants are owner in possession of the same. At last contesting respondents/defendant prayed for dismissal of the application.

In given circumstances this court is of the affirm view that the respective stance alleged by both the parties to the suit is subject to proof after recording of pro and contra evidence and furthermore, in absence of revenue record in district Orakzai, at this stage it is not possible for this court to ascertain that as who amongst the parties to the suit is real owner of the suit property. However, in order to preserve the suit property from alienation or from changing its nature during the pendency of instant suit, this court deem it appropriate to restrain respondents to this effect.
