

Petitioner through counsel present. Record received. Counsel for the applicant/petitioner has filed an application seeking correction of inadvertent mistake occurred in the record, wherein the *engine number* was mistakenly mentioned in place of the *registration number* and the *registration number* was mistakenly mentioned in place of the *chassis number*.

Counsel for petitioner said that mistake is purely clerical in nature and has occurred inadvertently while recording the particulars of the vehicle. It is prayed that necessary correction may kindly be made in the record to avoid any future complications.

Record reveals that the said mistake is only of clerical/typographical nature and no prejudice would be caused to any of the parties if the correction is allowed. Accordingly, the application is **allowed**. Office is directed to make necessary correction in the record by mentioning the correct *engine number*, *registration number*, and *chassis number* as per the relevant documents of the vehicle.

Petitioner, namely Umar Saeed S/O Safar Gul resident of Qoun Mishti, Village Anjghali, Tehsil Central District Orakzai is seeking return of Motor Car having registration No. VV-779, Chassis No. CE106-0114117, Engine

No. 3432979 Color white, Model 1997 taken into possession by the local police in case FIR No. 78 dated 14.09.2025 U/S 382, 506, 511, 341, 34 PPC registered at Police Station Mishti Mela.

Record reveals that motorcar in question was taken into possession by the local police in the above cited case, however, today petitioner produced original relevant document in respect of motorcar. Original seen and returned. Copy attached with petition and there is no rival claimant of the same. Resultantly, the application is accepted and it is directed that the Motorcar in question be handed over to the petitioner, subject to surety bond to the tune of Rs. 500,000/- with two sureties to the satisfaction of SHO Police Station concerned. Petitioner is directed that, neither to sell out the said motor car nor to change the nature i.e. color etc. Petitioner shall produce the same as and when required.
