

**Case Title: State Vs Sadiq Ali**

Order No. 03	13.10.2025	<p>This order decides instant inquiry proceedings initiated against Mr. Sadiq Ali, Sweeper at Kalaya.</p> <p><b>Brief Account:</b></p> <p>Learned CJ-II at Kalaya called upon Mr. Sadiq Ali to explain his conduct when the latter absented himself from work from 15-05-25 to 03-06-25, without applying for formal sanction for leave. The learned judge found his explanation dissatisfactory and requested for proceedings to be initiated against him.</p> <p>Accordingly, proceedings were initiated against him, and this order shall conclude it.</p> <p><b>Reasons:</b></p> <p>During the course of the inquiry, it came to our knowledge that Mr. Sadiq Ali was arrested by the local police and was detention from 17-05-25 to 03-06-25. The fact was formally confirmed Superintendent Prisons vide letter no 1952 dated 30-09-25, available on file.</p> <p>As per E&amp;D Rules section 06 sub clause 02, an official committed to prison shall be considered as under suspension for the period of detention without the formal approval of the competent authority.</p> <p>Since the law lays down that during the period of arrest, a person is to be considered as under suspension, the question of absence without leave does not arise.</p> <p>In view of the foregone, the undersigned does not find any willful misconduct or default. Accordingly, instant inquiry is disposed.
