

ORDER

Abid Ali Advocate for accused/petitioner and Sr. PP,
Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. I
heard arguments and perused the record.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Abdul Qayyum** s/o Muhammad
Nazir seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 22,
Dated 17.09.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of
Police Station Ghiljo. As per contents of FIR, the
complainant, Saleem Khan SHO along with other
police contingents laid a picket on the spot on
17.09.2025 when a person holding a white shopper in
his hand arrived there from Dabori at 1110 hours. He
was stopped. From the said shopper, the complainant
recovered 04 packets, each containing 1100 grams of
chars and wrapped in yellow scotch tape. The person
revealed his identity as Abdul Qayyum s/o
Muhammad Nazir. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the
record, it was found that though the
accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR
for the offence falling within the prohibitory clause


of 497 CrPC. However, the report of FSL is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to the concession of bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.
