ORDER


Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner

received. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Zahoor Jan** s/o Gul Muhammad
seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 62, Dated
10.10.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police
Station Kurez Boya. As per contents of FIR, the
complainant, SHO Hajat Hassan, along with other
police contingents during surveillance duty of the
area were present on main road Tazi Khel on
10.10.2025 when a person, while holding a blue
plastic shopper in his right-hand, was coming
towards them at 1300 hours. He was stopped. From
the said shopper, the complainant recovered 02
packets of chars wrapped in yellow scotch tape and
weighing 1200 grams, making a total of 2400 grams.
Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with the allegation of recovery of 2400 grams of chars. However, the report of FSL is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact makes the case one of further inquiry.
4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
