

As per contents of FIR, the complainant, Hajat Hassan SHO along with other police contingents during surveillance duty of the area were present on main road Tazi Khel on 26.09.2025 when a Flying-Coach bearing Registration No. IDS 5171/Islamabad arrived there at 1000 hours. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was debordered. The complainant recovered two packets of opium wrapped in yellow scotch tape from a secret cavity inside the vehicle.
