

ORDER

Shahid Khan Afridi for the accused/petitioners and Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioners, Zeeshan Ahmad s/o Sahib Gul and Gul Islam s/o Bazar Gul seek their post arrest bail in case FIR No. 116, Dated 12.10.2025, u/s 9 (1) 3 (e) CNSA & 15AA of Police Station Kalaya. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, SHO Imtiaz Khan along with other police contingents, while responding to the information of smuggling of huge quantity of chars towards Anjani via motorcar, laid a barricade on main metaled road near Mandra Khel Check-Post when a hybrid motorcar arrived there from Feroz Khel side at 1600 hours. The motorcar was stopped. The complainant recovered a Kalashnikov bearing No. CM00834 with a fixed and a spare charger containing 50 rounds from the person occupying the front seat. He was disembarked who disclosed his identity as Zeeshan Ahmad. He could not produce any license or permit for the said Kalashnikov. The driver of the motorcar was also disembarked, who revealed his identity as Gul Islam. Upon search of the motorcar, the

complainant recovered 05 packets of chars wrapped in

yellow scotch tape and weighing 1000 grams each,

making a total of 5000 grams, from a secret cavity in

one of the back doors of the vehicle and 05 packets of

chars wrapped in yellow scotch tape and weighing

1000 grams each, making a total of 5,000, from a

secret cavity in the other door. The complainant also

recovered 10 packets of chars wrapped in yellow

scotch tape and weighing 1000 grams, making a total

of 10,000 grams, from a secret cavity in a loudspeaker

in the trunk of the vehicle. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the

record, it was found that the accused/petitioners are

directly charged in the FIR for the commission of

offence falling under the prohibitory clause of Section

497 CrPC. Sufficient material is available on file

which reasonably connects the accused/petitioners

with the commission of offence. The route permit

certificate is also available on file.

4. In such circumstances, the petitioners are not entitled

to the concession of bail at this stage of the case.

Therefore, the application is rejected.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File

of this Court be consigned to record room after its

necessary completion and compilation.
