




Order No.02 03.11.2025		<p>chaddar, the complainant recovered 02 packets of chars wrapped in yellow scotch tape and weighing 1000 grams, making a total of 2000 grams.</p> <p>I heard counsels for the parties and perused the record.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the recovery has been made from personal possession of the accused and there is no secret cavity in the motorcycle. Moreover, the petitioner has produced documents regarding ownership of the motorcycle. There is no rival claimant of the motorcycle in question.</p> <p>The petition in hand is accepted and the motorcycle in question be returned to the petitioner subject to furnishing two surety bonds in the sum of Rs. 100,000/- to the satisfaction of SHO concerned. The petitioner is directed not to dispose of the motorcycle till final conclusion of the trial and produced the same as and whenever required to this Court or police.
