


Order No.02	05.11.2025	<p>Accused/petitioners, Abid Khan and Hafiz Khan on ad-interim pre-arrest bail along with counsel present. Record received. Complainant does not want to engage a private counsel.</p> <p>The accused/petitioners seek pre-arrest bail in case FIR No. 86, Dated 11.10.2025, u/s 379/506/504/34 PPC of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant namely Israfeel and others, vide Daily Diary No. 05 of 21.09.2025, made a report to the police to the effect that they have a joint mountain consists upon bulk of olive and cherri trees, situated at Dronr Sheikhan. They further reported that the accused Mirab Gul, Abid Khan and Hafiz Khan have cut and stolen the trees on 21.08.2025 at 1000 hours which caused them huge financial loss. The accused also criminally intimidated them. The SHO conducted inquiry on the report of complainant and filed the instant FIR against the accused.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that the accused/petitioners are charged in the FIR. Counsel for the accused/petitioners failed to point out any malafide or ulterior motive on behalf of complainant for implicating them in the instant case. Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled to pre-arrest bail at this stage. Therefore, ad-interim pre-arrest bail earlier granted to the accused/petitioners is hereby recalled and the BBA in hand resultantly stands dismissed.</p> <p>File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
