ORDER

Sana Ullah Khan Advocate for accused/petitioner and Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received. Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, Jameel Khan s/o Zartaj seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 92, Dated 31.10.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Mishti Mela. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, SHO Shal Muhammad along with other police contingents were on surveillance duty of the area when he received information regarding smuggling of chars by Jameel Khan from Mishti Mela via motorcycle. Upon this information, he laid a barricade on main road leading from Kalaya to Mishti Mela situated at Chapri Mor Sanghra on 31.10.2025 and intercepted a Honda motorcycle at about 1435 hours. The rider was disembarked who disclosed his name as Jameel Khan s/o Zartaj. The complainant recovered 03 packets of chars wrapped in yellow scotch tape and weighing 1000 grams,

making a total of 3000 grams, from a secret cavity in seat of the motorcycle. Hence, the present FIR.

- 3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR with the allegation of recovery of 3000 grams of chars. However, there is no application or route permit certificate to show that the samples were transmitted to FSL within the prescribed period of time. This fact makes the case of accused/petitioner one of further inquiry.
- 4 Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 50,000/-with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
- 5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.
 File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
