	into his fields, cut the crops and taken the same in a Pick-Up
	bearing No. C4043 and the son of complainant, who was
	present in the fields, was intimidated by them with weapons.
	Hence, the present FIR.
	After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record,
	it was found that the allegations against the
	accused/petitioners u/s 506 PPC falls within the bailable part
	of said Section. The act of cutting crops from five fields in
	presence of the complainant in a daylight by four persons
	only, does not seem to be an act of theft. The dispute in respect
	of the property from where the crops were cut down is evident
	from the statements of accused who have also produced some
	jirga verdicts in their favour with the admission of cutting the
	crops from their own fields. One of the accused is aged about
	77/78 years. In such circumstances, malafide on the part of
	complainant, in view of the said property dispute, cannot be
	ruled out.
	Hence, the application is accepted and ad-interim pre-
	arrest bail granted to the accused/petitioners is confirmed on
	the strength of existing bail bonds. File of this Court be
