**ORDER**

Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the state present. Counsel for the accused/petitioner present. Record received.

Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Muhammad Javid** s/o Latif Ullah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 31, Dated 16.12.2025 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (C) CNSA of Police Station Ghiljo. As per contents of FIR, SHO Saleem Khan along with other police contingents, during surveillance duty of the area, laid a barricade on Dabori Road Ghondake on 16.12.2025 when a person holding a white plastic shopper coming on foot arrived there at 1400 hours. He was stopped. From the said shopper, the complainant recovered 2400 grams. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR for the recovery of 2400 grams of chars. However, the FSL report is not available on file to show that

whether the recovered substance was actually chars  
or otherwise. This fact alone makes the case of  
accused/petitioner one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the  
accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to  
submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/-  
with two sureties each in the like amount to the  
satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local,  
reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file.  
File of this Court be consigned to record room after  
its necessary completion and compilation.
