

Sr. PP for the state present. Accused Mair Ali and Awan Ali are on bail present. Counsel for the accused already submitted application for pleading their guilt and disposal of the case with request for lenient view.

Record shows that complete challan was put in court on 03.07.2025. Provisions of section 241-A Cr.PC were complied with. Formal charge was framed on 26.07.2025. The accused did not plead their guilt at that time and claimed the trial and thereafter prosecution was directed to produce it evidence but the accused facing trial submitted application for pleading their guilt. After pleading their guilt, show cause notice under section 243 Cr.P.C was given to the accused as to why they should not be convicted. They opted not to submit reply, resultantly, they prayed for lenient view while placing themselves at the mercy of this court.

Keeping in view the whole-hearted plea of their guilt and their previous non-involvement in any such or any other criminal activity on their side, accused are sentenced to 06 months simple imprisonment and



fine of Rs. 20000/- for section 11 (1) (2) KP CNSA. In default of payment of the fine, accused shall undergo one-month simple imprisonment.

There is nothing on record which could show previous involvement of accused in such like cases, therefore, the sentence ibid is suspended and converted into probation and they are placed on probation for 10 Months under the Probation Ordinance. They shall remain under the supervision of the Probation Officer (male) for the above-mentioned period subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with two local and reliable sureties, to the satisfaction of probation officer (male) Orakzai, with the following conditions.

1. That they shall not repeat the offence.
2. That they shall keep and maintain peace and order in the society.
3. That he must exhibit good behavior during the prescribed period of probation.
4. That they shall appear before the probation officer once in a month, which date is left to the discretion of the probation officer to be fixed.
5. That they shall not leave the country without permission of probation officer.
6. That if they violate the above conditions, the bonds will be recalled and they will be proceeded in accordance with the provision of the Ordinance ibid.



7. That in case of default by the convict, the direction regarding probation shall stand recalled and convict shall undergo imprisonment accordingly.

It is further added that the Probation Officer may involve the accused/convict in community services.

The Probation Officer (male) is directed to submit their report to this court about their character and conditions as aforesaid once in a quarter.

Copy of this order be sent to the probation officer for compliance as per law. Case property be dealt with in accordance with law if any.

File be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
