Order No.05 15.01.2026		<p>On the same day, one Imtiaz Ali also made a report to the local police at 1930 hours, vide Daily Diary No. 21 of 22.09.2025, to the effect that the accused Shahid Khan and other persons including the accused/petitioners herd their cattle to his fields causing damage to the crop. He told them that their cattle have been causing damage to his crops for a few days. An altercation started between them and the accused assaulted him and tried to abduct him, when, in the meanwhile, firing started from Koko Dara and the accused abandoned him. He further reported that he found that two of the accused sustained injuries as a result of firing their companions. Motive behind the occurrence was herding cattle in the fields.</p> <p>After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that there is delay of almost 04 hours in lodging the report. More than 13 accused have been charged for the commission of offence. There is no medical report in support of the allegations of beating the complainant by the petitioners. The instant report seems to be counterblast of FIR No. 53 of the same day in which two persons sustained injuries from the accused party; thus, malafide and false implication of the accused/petitioners by the complainant cannot be ruled out. Above all, BBA petition of co-accused with similar role have already been accepted; therefore, the instant BBA petitioner is also accepted on the basis of rule of consistency and ad-interim pre-arrest bail granted earlier to the accused/petitioners is confirmed on the strength of existing bail bonds.
