Sr. PP for the state present. Petitioner Abdullah in person along with counsel present. Record received. Arguments heard and record perused.

Petitioner namely **Abdullah S/O Laiq Khan R/O Koki Khel**, Jamrud, District Khyber is seeking return of NDP motorcar, Model 2014 MIRA, bearing Chassis No. LA300S-1237611, has taken into possession by the local police in case FIR No. 02, dated: 05.01.2026 U/S 419/420/468/471/34 PPC of Police Station Mishti Mela.

Record reveals that motorcar in question was taken into possession by the local police in the above cited case and is in the custody of local police of PS Kalaya. Original documents produced and returned after examination. Petitioner is the last possessor of the said vehicle. Copies of the sale deed dated 15.12.2025 is annexed with the petition. The vehicle in question is duly registered as NDP vehicles, which per government policy for NMDs are permitted on roads in erstwhile FATA. There is no rival claimant of the vehicle. The vehicle is parked in open space which is likely to be rusted, damaged and deteriorated.

Detention of vehicle in question in police custody for indefinite period would also achieve no useful purpose. Release of the vehicle on Superdari to the petitioner will not create any vested right in his favor qua the vehicle as Superdari is only a temporary arrangement for the custody of the property during pending inquiry/trial.

As petitioner is the last possessor and the vehicle in question and the same is no more required to the local police for investigation, resultantly, the application is accepted and it is directed that the vehicle in question be handed over to the petitioner, subject to surety bonds to the tune of Rs. 10,50000/- each with two sureties to the satisfaction of SHO Police Station concerned. Petitioner shall produce the same as and when required. Record be returned back to the quarter concerned. Copy of the order be placed on file.
