ORDER

Asad Ijaz Advocate for accused/petitioner and Sr. PP,

Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received.

Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Nazeef Khan** s/o Abdul Saeed, after being refused to be released on bail vide order dated 15.12.2025 passed by the Court of learned Judicial Magistrate-II, Tehsil Court Kalaya, seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 119, Dated 15.10.2025 registered u/s 11 (1) 2 CNSA of Police Station Kalaya. As per contents of FIR, the complainant, SHO Imtiaz Khan along with other police contingents, during surveillance duty of the area, were present on main pukhta road near Utman Khel Check-Post on 15.10.2025 when a person was going at 1620 hours. He was stopped. The complainant recovered a white plastic shopper from his side pocket leading to the recovery of 35 grams of ICE. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the


accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR for the recovery of 35 grams of ICE. However, the offence for which he is charged does not attract the prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. This fact alone makes the case of accused/petitioner one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 50,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
