**JUDGMENT**

This judgment decides instant case filed by Mr. Wali Khan for correction of his date of birth in his record as maintained by the defendants.

**Pleadings:**

The claim as related in the plaint reads that correct date of birth of the plaintiff is 01.01.1967 while the defendants have erroneously recorded the same as 12.12.1971 It is further alleged that when defendant was requested to rectify the mistake extra-judicially, they declined, hence the suit.

Defendants were summoned, defendant No.1 appeared through his representative Mr. Iftikhar Ahmad, who submitted written statement while defendant No. 2 placed and proceeded ex-parte.


During the scheduling conference within the meaning of order IX-A of CPC, it was revealed that the matter involved in the instant case involves simple adjudication, which can be decided through summary judgement as per relevant and admitted record.

To this effect notice was given to the parties that why not the case in hand be decided on the basis of available record without recording lengthy evidence, as the primary aim and objective of Amended Management Rules in CPC is, "*to enable the court to-*

- a. Deal with the cases justly and fairly;*
- b. Encourage parties to alternate dispute resolution procedure if it considers appropriate;*
- c. Save expense and time both of courts and litigants;*
- and*
- d. Enforce compliance with provisions of this Code."*

Learned counsel for plaintiff and representative for the defendant No.1 heard and record gone through.

The record reveals that the plaintiff's date of birth, as mentioned in his first CNIC and Passport, is **01.01.1967**. However, after the renewal of his CNIC and

Passport, the defendants have incorrectly recorded his date of birth as 12.12.1971.


The record clearly establishes that the date of birth was modified at the application of the plaintiff from the one claimed to the one impugned. Besides, he has passports too issued with both dates.

In a candid admission, plaintiff's counsel conceded that his client is an emigrant worker in UAE where he is facing Visa Issues due to the discrepancy in his dates. He furnished copies of applications allegedly submitted there for Visa processing and rejected by the authorities.

Plaintiff wishes to return back to his original date of birth prior to its modification into the current one. He is stuck in a legal issue abroad due to the variance in his date of birth. The date he presently claims will shorten his career/service tenure, hence the regular malafide of seeking to extend the period cannot be attributed as motive to him.

In the situation in hand, the best solution, if not a good one, is to grant the prayer, so as to remove future complications.

Consequently, upon what has been discussed above and the jurisdiction vested in this court under Wajid Khan VS NADRA Case No. 7/1 of 2025 Page 3 of 4

order IX-A and XV-A of CPC, suit of the plaintiff succeeds and is hereby **decreed** as prayed for. Correct date of birth of the plaintiff is declared as **01.01.1967**. Defendant is advised to bring his record in line with this judgment. Costs shall follow.
