ORDER

Abid Ali Advocate for accused/petitioner and Sr. PP,

Abul Qasim for the State present. Record received.

Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Zardad Khan** s/o Habib Ullah seeks his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 16, Dated 29.01.2026 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (c) CNSA of Police Station Kalaya. As per contents of the FIR, the complainant, SHO Muhammad Jameel along with other police contingent laid a barricade on Main Pukhta Road Mandra Khel Police Check-Post on 29.01.2026 when a Double Cabin Pick-Up bearing Registration No. GTD6653 arrived there from Feroz Khel at 1545 hours. The vehicle was stopped and the driver was disembarked who disclosed his name as Zardad Khan. The complainant recovered a blue plastic envelope from behind the back seat of the vehicle which led him to the recovery of 03 packets of chars, each wrapped in yellow scotch tape and weighing 1200 grams, making a total of 3600 grams. Hence, the present FIR.



3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the record, it was found that though the accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR and the offence for which he is charged attracts the prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. However, the report of FSL is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact alone makes the case of accused/petitioner one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.

5. Copy of this Order be placed on police/judicial file. File of this Court be consigned to record room after its necessary completion and compilation.
