ORDER

Ishtiaq Ur Rehman Advocate for accused/petitioner  
and Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the State present.

Arguments heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Muhammad Arif** s/o  
Muhammad Usman seeks his post-arrest bail in case  
FIR No. 03, Dated 09.02.2026 registered u/s 9 (1) 3  
(c) CNSA of Police Station Ghiljo. As per contents  
of the FIR, the complainant, ASHO Tajmeen Khan  
along with other police contingent laid a barricade on  
Ghiljo to Dabori Road near THQ Hospital  
09.02.2026 when a person was coming from  
Khadizai at 1600 hours who was having a white bag  
on his shoulders. He was stopped. From the said bag,  
the complainant recovered 4000 grams of chars  
garda. Hence, the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the  
record, it was found that though the  
accused/petitioner is directly nominated in the FIR  
and the offence for which he is charged attracts the  
prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C. However,


the report of FSL is not available on file to show that whether the recovered substance was actually chars or otherwise. This fact alone makes the case of accused/petitioner one of further inquiry.

4. Hence, in view of what is discussed above, the accused/petitioner is admitted to bail subject to submission of bail bonds to the tune of Rs. 100,000/- with two sureties each in the like amount to the satisfaction of this Court. The sureties must be local, reliable and men of means.
