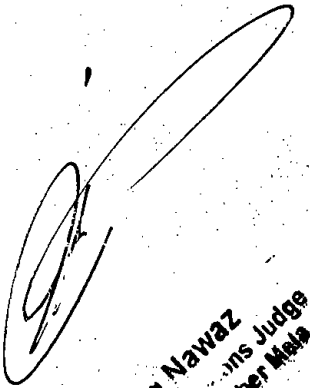

ORDER

Mr. Sanaullah Advocate for accused/petitioner and
Sr. PP, Abul Qasim for the state present. Arguments
heard and record perused.

2. Accused/petitioner, **Amil Khan** s/o Said Wazir seeks
his post-arrest bail in case FIR No. 85, Dated
17.06.2026 registered u/s 9 (1) 3 (d) CNSA of Police
Station Kalaya. As per contents of the FIR, the
complainant, SHO Hajat Hassan, along with other
police contingent, while on routine patrolling duty
reached to the place of occurrence. Upon seeing a
pedestrian having a yellow plastic sack hanging from
his shoulder, was stopped being suspicious, but
nothing incriminating was recovered from his
possession. Upon checking the said sack, the
complainant recovered 6000 grams of chars. Hence,
the present FIR.

3. After hearing both the parties and perusal of the
record, it was found that the accused/petitioner is
directly nominated in the FIR with the allegations of
recovery of a huge quantity of 6000 grams of chars

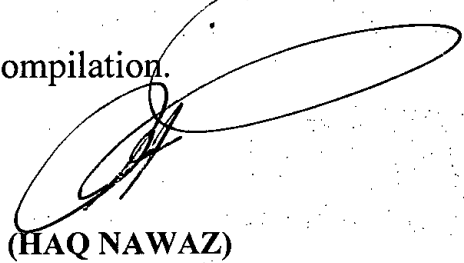
from direct possession of the accused/petitioner.

Application for FSL is available on record with copy of the route permit which shows that the samples were timely transmitted to FSL. The offence for which he is charged attracts the prohibitory clause of section 497 Cr.P.C Hence, the accused/petitioner is not entitled for the concession of bail at this stage. Accordingly, for the stated reasons, bail petition in hand stands dismissed being meritless.
