Accused produced in custody. <i>Be registered.</i> As per record, accused have been charged for possessing of two unlicensed 30-bore pistols without numbers alongwith fixed chargers containing 13 cartridges of the same bore from the accused Sher Khan and Hadiq Khan respectively, vide FIR No.99 dated 15.07.2026 under section 15 Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Arms Act, 2013 police station Kalaya. Accused submitted applications for plead guilty for the reason mentioned therein and are placed on file. Complete challan against the accused was put in court on today and after 241-A Cr.P.C proceedings, the accused were formally charge sheeted and they pleaded their guilt. In this respect, today they filed applications for pleading their guilt and requested for lenient view. After pleading their guilt, show cause notices under section 243 Cr.P.C. were given to the accused as to why they should not be convicted. Resultantly, they prayed for lenient view while placing himself at the mercy of this court. Keeping in mind the wholehearted confession of guilt by the accused being first offenders, a lenient view is taken. Accused are convicted and sentenced to suffer imprisonment of TRC and with a fine of Rs.500/- each.

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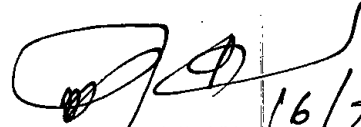
